

## Playing the role of the resident

You are expected to play the role of a resident today for the Clinical Skills Test.

The nurse giving your test will pair you with another candidate for the purpose of playing the resident during each other's tests. Your role as resident requires that you allow skills to be performed on you by another candidate. To decide the best pairing of candidates, the nurse needs be aware of any reasons that may affect what skills can be performed on you.

Please read the questions below. *When you check-in, tell the nurse if your answer is “**NO**” to any of the questions. You will only need to provide general information, not any specific medical information.*

The questions below are being asked only to determine what skills can be performed on you when you play the resident.

Skill	Questions
<b>Feeding</b>	Are you <u>able</u> to eat a snack, such as applesauce or pudding?
<b>Hand and nail care</b>	Are you <u>able</u> to have: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ lotion applied to a hand?</li> <li>✓ fingernails cleaned and filed?</li> </ul>
<b>Foot care</b>	Are you <u>able</u> to have: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ a foot washed?</li> <li>✓ lotion applied to a foot?</li> </ul>
<b>Mouth care</b>	Are you <u>able</u> to have your teeth brushed with a toothbrush? Are you <u>able</u> to have your gums cleaned with a toothbrush?
<b>Range of motion exercises</b>	Are you <u>able</u> to have your shoulders, elbows and wrists moved? Are you <u>able</u> to have your hips, knees and ankles moved?
<b>Transfer or Ambulation</b>	Are you <u>able</u> to have a <b>gait belt</b> applied around your waist?  ( <u>Note</u> : If you are pregnant, you should tell the nurse your answer to this question is “ <b>NO</b> , you cannot have a gait belt applied to your waist.” This is because applying a gait belt to the waist of a person who is pregnant is not recommended.)

## Taking your test

Should you have a physical condition that affects your ability to safely take your test, and performing any skill could cause physical harm to you, you should not test today. Any candidate that requires special accommodations must notify Prometric in writing prior to the testing date. Follow the procedures for requesting ADA accommodations.
